In some ways we are familiar with this ministry, though we may not know it. For the last 11 weeks, we have enjoyed a video series by Dr. Derek Thomas on *The Book of Job*. On other occasions we watched videos on *The Holiness of God* and *Psalms 53* (both by Dr. RC Sproul). All of these video series were produced by Ligonier. In reality, though, they are a very small sampling of a great wealth of video lectures.

It is with high regard that I recommend the link below. There you will find access to more than 2,500 messages scattered over 200+ topics. You will find subjects on *marriage, suffering, OT, NT, assurance, church history*, and many more. Of course, as with any teaching ministry, biblical discernment should always be given. Many of the lectures are taught by Presbyterian ministers, so we would not be able to fully embrace everything that is said. However, the heart and passion of these men will be brought out as they endeavor to feed you the word of God.

Finally, since these videos have been produced over the course of many decades, you will notice a definite change in styles, backgrounds, and appearances. And while it is possible to allow the visual to stand in the way of the audible, if you are distracted, you can always turn the screen away and simply listen to what is said.
